He holds Bachelor of Music, Master of Music and Doctor of Musical Arts degrees as well as a degree in Lieder and Oratorio from the prestigious Mozarteum in Salzburg, Austria. His performing experience includes his operatic debut with the Swiss national opera as well as concert work in 16 countries. He recently made his solo debut at Carnegie Hall about which the New York Times said, "Dr. Seelig's voice is lovely, fresh and supple, capable of power, and he is in command of the languages and styles he essays."



JOE SNYDER

Mr. Snyder enters his second year as principal accompanist for the Chorale. He holds a Bachelor of Music Education from Concordia College and the Master of Arts in Piano Performance from Stephen F. Austin State University. In addition to his responsibilities with the Chorale, Mr. Snyder teaches music at the Episcopal School of Dallas and is the organist at the Lakewood United Methodist Church. He is a member of Texas Music Educators Association, American Choral Directors Association, and Pi Kappa Lambda.
